International events provide an excellent opportunity to tautoko the aspirations of Māori and manaaki other indigenous peoples through active participation, advocacy and sharing of knowledge. This is achieved through kanohi ki te kanohi engagement.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- Be indigenous
- · Reside outside Aotearoa, New Zealand

Conditions

- Applicants must have written support from two referees from your indigenous communities or employer
- · Applicants need to provide a <u>breakdown</u> of financial costs on how the funds will be used
- Preference will be given to applicants residing in the Pacific
- If fund is being utilised for registration costs, these will be based on early bird costs
- Successful applicants must:
 - Supply receipts for use of funds
 - Provide a detailed report to Ngā Kaiwhakahau (https://trw.org.nz/contact/) within one month of completion of the forum
 - Write freely accessible online article (500-1,000 words) within one month of completion of the forum which will be linked from the Te Rōpū Whakahau website OR
 - Provide a freely accessible online presentation (5-10 minutes) reflecting on their learnings from the forum
 - Acknowledge the NZ National Commission for UNESCO in the introduction to their article or presentation
- Conduct that reflects positively and enhances the reputation of Te Ropū Whakahau is expected at all times
